







Short-Manual for i3-mini-Max vertical garden

 <p><i>Tip: Before filling, the bag should be nicely attached to the body wall</i></p>	<p>content: 2x body parts(1+2), 1x base plate(3), 1x i3-Dock Sets (4) à 8 pcs with i3-lids, 1x mounting-set „mini-Max“ (2x fixing screws -base-plate(5), 4x screws&nuts; i3-sticker), 1x substrate-bag</p> <p>A steadily growing range of accessories, tips and tricks, FAQ's and much more can be found at: https://i3-garden.com/shop/</p> <p>Do not use "sharp" cleaning agents.</p> <p>➤ Explanation: This product was produced with the utmost care 100% in the EU. All the system materials used correspond to the "EU Directive 1935/2004/EC" "food-safe".</p>	
 <p><i>For some regions, the body is pre-assembled.</i></p>	<p>Step1 – corpus Connect the 2 body parts with the screws (outside) + nuts (inside). -The mounting strips of body part(1) (=with sticker on top) are outside = overlap the body part (2)</p>	 <p>Step2 –connect the base plate with the corpus (optional) Connect the base plate to the corpus with 2 screws M4.</p>  <p><i>Base plate with drain hose for overwater</i></p>
 <p><i>Tip: After approx. 15cm filling, pull the bag up several times to make sure that the floor is filled nicely.</i></p>	<p>Step3 –Inserting the substrate bag, filling and planting Insert the substrate bag – make sure that the substrate bag is smoothly attached to the body wall.</p> <p><i>Tip: Pull the bag for filling over the body edge. After filling, put it inside the earth, as the earth substrate drops down over time = refill after about 4 weeks.</i></p>	 <p><i>Drain hose for overwater</i></p> <p>Step4 -Filling and planting Opening the plant bag planting positions: Here, users sometimes simply cut a cross into the bag instead of cutting out the bag round here. The material then forms a roof over the roots, i.e. the water does not come directly to the roots.</p>

- When **assembling the i-Docks**-please make sure that the 3 parts of the i-docks can be squeezed tightly together (usually you hear a "click"). Otherwise, inserting it into the planting plate can be tedious.
- **Planting in the i-Dock:** Here the mistake is often made that too much earth substrate is pressed from the front into the i-docks onto the roots – just fill it loosely with soil, then the roots grow very quickly into the earth bag.
1=New-Planting, 2= Re-Planting
- **Plant plates:** the CNC outbreaks of the planting plate are no waste! Please use these as **reusable planting signs** (with a pencil).
